

Terrence is Grateful

Terrence was at the end of his world. His addiction to crack cocaine had robbed him of everything — his family, friends, and his self-respect. In High School, Terrence excelled in football and was hoping to get a scholarship at a prestigious college. In his senior year, he had a horrific injury that shattered his knee as well as his college dreams. He was devastated.

Terrence tried to shake it off and enrolled in a local college, but just couldn't get over the loss of his football career. He started drinking and that progressed to drug usage. He battled drugs and alcohol for many years and just didn't want to continue his life. He was living on the streets and visited the Center for food and clothing.

Last year, he happened to come for a meal during the **Bombastic Birthday Party** (see below) that is held once a year for the homeless and needy. Of all things, this particular day was his birthday. Terrence believes that God spoke to him that day. He started to believe that there was a purpose for his life and realized that people cared about him. Terrence entered the residential program that day and has since found employment and housing. He is also enrolled in school to become an EMT.

"I'm so appreciative of all that was given to me during the program. I came in one day for a meal, had my birthday celebrated and then started my new life. I really want to thank everyone for giving. You really have helped me."



With the help of countless volunteers, donors and supporters, our centers held the annual **Bombastic Birthday Party** for over 1,000 homeless and needy individuals. This year's celebration was on June 7th, where guests were treated to a wonderful meal, live entertainment, birthday cake, and presents. It was a huge party.
